## VILLAGE OF TWIN LAKES RESOLUTION 2024-8-2

#### **RESOLUTION OF VILLAGE BOARD EXERCISING REFERENDUM OPTION**

#### Village of Twin Lakes, Kenosha County

Whereas, the State of Wisconsin has imposed limits on town, village, city and county property tax levies under Wis. Stat. sec. 66.0602; and

Whereas, Wis. Stat. sec. 66.0602 limits the increase in 2024 (to be collected in 2025) to the local property tax levy to no more than the greater of (a) 0% of last year's actual levy or (b) a percentage equal to the percentage change in equalized value due to new construction less improvements removed; which for the Village of Twin Lakes is to be 0.951%; and

Whereas, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Twin Lakes, Kenosha County believes it is in the Village's best interest to exceed the state levy limit as described above by a greater percentage than 0.951% for the purpose of providing funding for four (4) emergency medical service positions; and

Whereas, the Village of Twin Lakes actual levy in 2023 (collected in 2024) was 4,427,532; and state law would limit the increase to 51,833 for a total allowable 2024 (collected in 2025) village tax levy of 4,479,365.

Now, Therefore the Board of Trustees of the Village of Twin Lakes, Kenosha County does hereby resolve and order as follows:

- The Village Board supports an increase in the Village tax levy for 2024 (to be collected in 2025) that will exceed the amount allowed by the state levy limit by <u>11.752 percent</u> (\$526,436 ÷ \$4,479,365), which would increase the Village levy by <u>\$526,436</u> for a total Village tax levy (after adjustments) of <u>\$5,005,801</u>. The requested increase would apply <u>on an ongoing basis</u>.
- 2. The Village Board directs that the question of increasing the allowable Village tax levy for 2024 (to be collected in 2025) by 11.752 percent over the 2024 allowable levy be put to referendum at an election on November 5, 2024.
- 3. The question shall be submitted to the electors as follows: "Under state law, the increase in the levy of the Village of Twin Lakes for the tax to be imposed for the next fiscal year, 2025, is limited to 0.951%, which results in a levy of \$4,479,365. Shall the Village of Twin Lakes be allowed to exceed this limit and increase the levy for the next fiscal year, 2025, for the purpose of providing funding for four (4) emergency medical service positions, by a total of 11.752%, which results in a levy of \$5,005,801, and on an ongoing basis, include the increase of \$526,436 for each fiscal year going forward?"

#### <u>A RESOLUTION TO BORROW \$220,000.00</u> <u>FROM THE TRUST FUNDS OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN</u>.

By the provisions of Sec. 24.66 of the Wisconsin Statutes, all municipalities may borrow money for such purposes in the manner prescribed, and,

By the provisions of Chapter 24 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Board of Commissioners of Public Lands of Wisconsin is authorized to make loans from the State Trust Funds to municipalities for such purposes. (Municipality as defined by Sec. 24.60(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes means a town, village, city, county, public inland lake protection and rehabilitation district, town sanitary district created under Sec. 60.71 or 60.72, metropolitan sewerage district created under Sec. 281.43(4), school district or technical college district.)

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of Twin Lakes, in the County of Kenosha, Wisconsin, borrow from the Trust Funds of the State of Wisconsin the sum of **Two Hundred Twenty Thousand and** 00/100 Dollars (\$220,000.00) for the purpose of financing the purchase of an ambulance and for no other purpose.

The loan is to be payable within 10 years from the 15th day of March preceding the date the loan is made. The loan will be repaid in annual installments with interest at the rate of 5.50 percent per annum from the date of making the loan to the 15th day of March next and thereafter annually as provided by law.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that there shall be raised and there is levied upon all taxable property, within the Village of Twin Lakes, in the County of Kenosha, Wisconsin, a direct annual tax for the purpose of paying interest and principal on the loan as they become due.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that no money obtained by the Village of Twin Lakes by such loan from the state be applied or paid out for any purpose except **financing the purchase of an ambulance** without the consent of the Board of Commissioners of Public Lands.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that in case the Board of Commissioners of Public Lands of Wisconsin agrees to make the loan, that the President and Clerk of the Village of Twin Lakes, in the County of Kenosha, Wisconsin, are authorized and empowered, in the name of the Village to execute and deliver to the Commission, certificates of indebtedness, in such form as required by the Commission, for any sum of money that may be loaned to the Village pursuant to this resolution. The President and Clerk of the Village will perform all necessary actions to fully carry out the provisions of Chapter 24 Wisconsin Statutes, and these resolutions.

We, the undersigned president and clerk of the Village of Twin Lakes, in the County(ies) of Kenosha, Wisconsin, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 24 of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby make application for a loan of Two Hundred Twenty Thousand And 00/100 Dollars (\$220,000.00) from the Trust Funds of the State of Wisconsin for the purpose of financing the purchase of ambulance.

The loan is to be continued for a term of 10 years from the 15th day of March preceding the date the loan is made. The loan is to be repaid in annual installments, as provided by law, with interest at the rate of 5.50 percent per annum.

We agree to the execution and signing of such certificates of indebtedness as the Board may prepare and submit, all in accordance with Chapter 24, Wisconsin Statutes.

The application is based upon compliance on the part of the Village with the provisions and regulations of the statutes above referred to, as set forth by the following statements which we do hereby certify to be correct and true.

The meeting of the village board of the Village of Twin Lakes, in the County(ies) of Kenosha, Wisconsin, which approved and authorized this application for a loan was a regularly called meeting held on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_.

At the aforesaid meeting a resolution was passed by a vote of not less than a majority of the members of the village board approving and authorizing an application to the Board of Commissioners of Public Lands, State of Wisconsin, for a loan of Two Hundred Twenty Thousand And 00/100 Dollars (\$220,000.00) from the Trust Funds of the State of Wisconsin to the Village of Twin Lakes, in the County(ies) of Kenosha, Wisconsin, for the purpose of financing the purchase of ambulance.
