# Discussion and possible action regarding an Event Permit for a Lake Elizabeth Manor Golf Cart Parade on September 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Dorsie Stanley, 1707 Willow Road, the organizer of the event, spoke and provided an explanation, clarifying that she is only requesting approval for the parade and is not seeking to legalize golf carts. The board imposed several restrictions: only golf carts are allowed (no lawn mowers), Esch Road cannot be used, a lead cart with rotating or hazard lights is required, along with an end cart also equipped with lights, and communication via walkie-talkies with the lead and end carts. Additionally, no driving is permitted on the baseball diamond, and only residents of the subdivision will be allowed to participate in the parade.

The event time was amended to start at 10:30 a.m. to allow attendees to drive to the park, with the parade beginning at 11:00 a.m. and ending at 2:00 p.m. Alcohol is not permitted in the park.

Peggy Pytko, 1937 Sunset Dr, expressed her concerns about the event. Police Chief Hall noted she will attend the event to ensure safety.

Skinner/Fitzgerald motion to approve Event Permit for the Lake Elizabeth Manor Golf Cart Parade on September 22<sup>nd</sup> from 10:30 am to 2:00 pm with restrictions as discussed. Motion carried 5 to 0.
